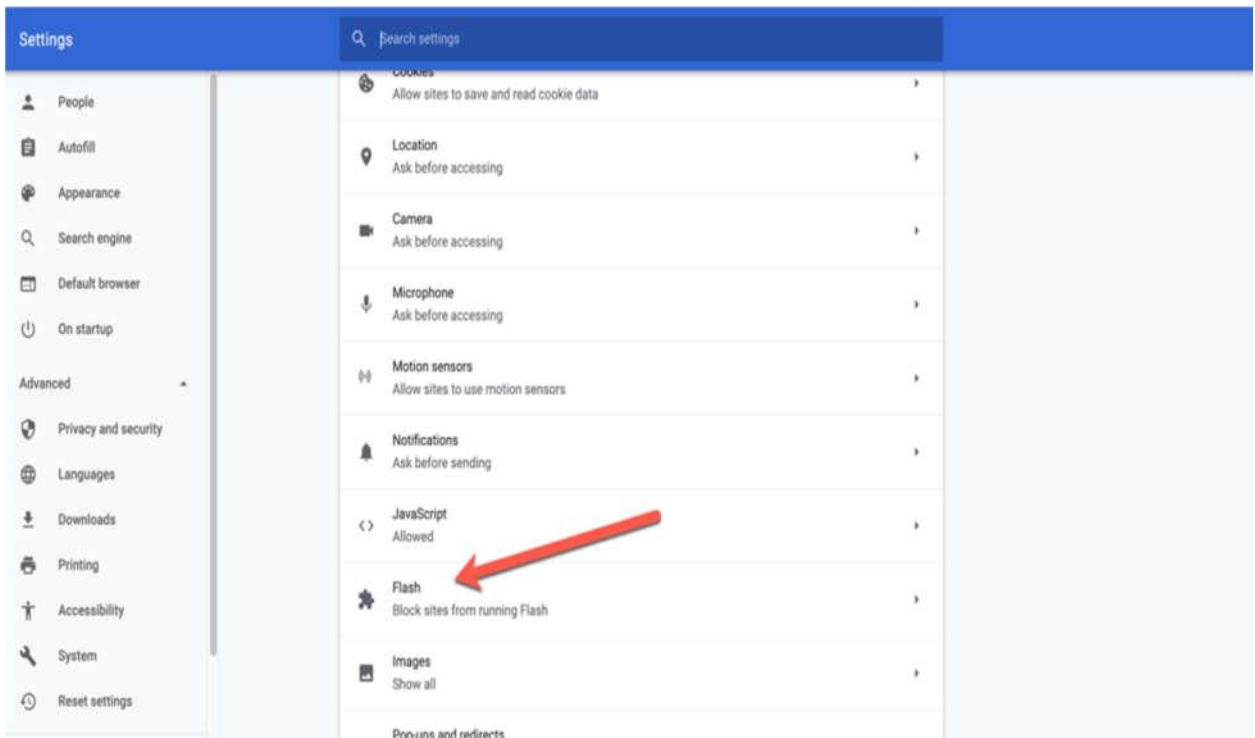


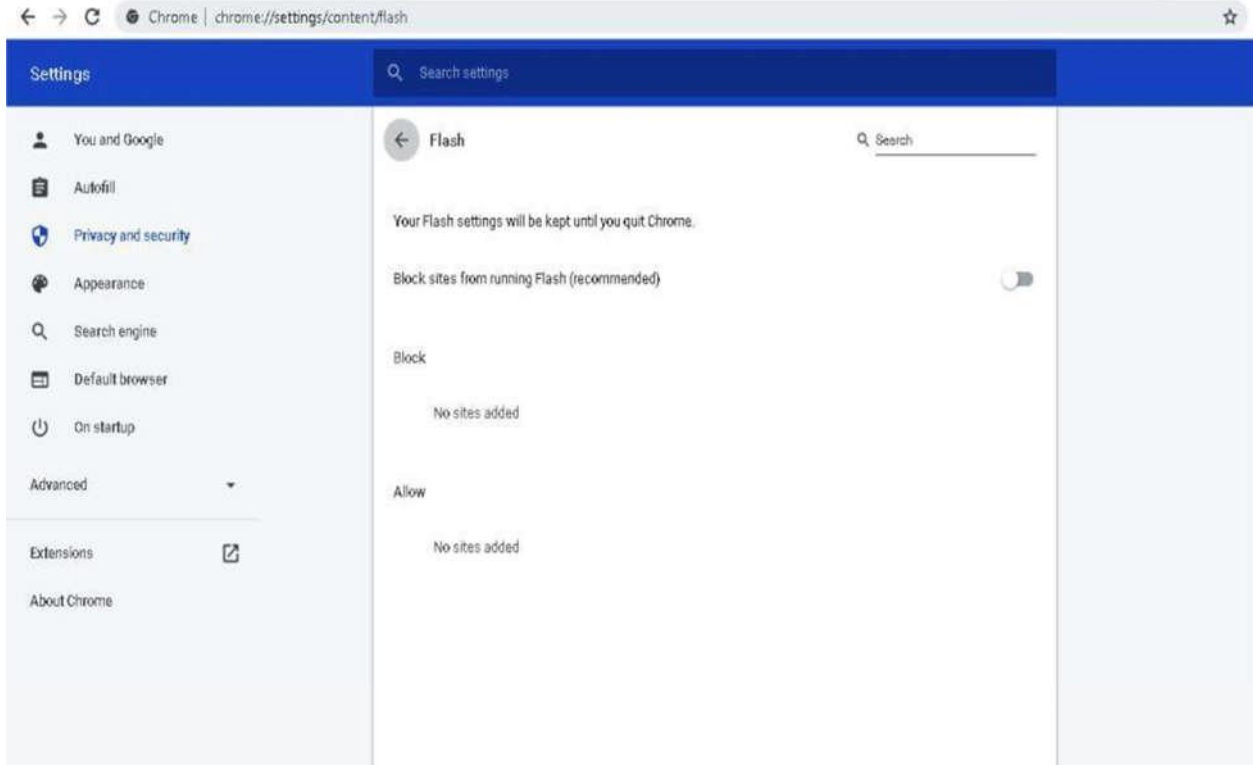
How to enable Flash player in Chrome

1. chrome://settings/content



2. Allow Flash to run

Click on "Flash" and, where it says "Block sites from running Flash (recommended)", toggle the switch on. It'll now say "Ask first":


